Technologists holding the CNCT credential must obtain 30 Continuing Education Units (CEUs) over the 5-year certification cycle. Credits submitted must be related to the performance of NCSs and not other neurodiagnostic techniques unrelated to NCSs, such as electroencephalogram (EEG), intraoperative neuromonitoring (IOM), or polysomnograms (PSG). The CEUs can be broken out as follows:

- 10 of the 30 CEUs may be from within your own institution
- 20 of the 30 CEUs must be from external sources
- 5 of the 30 CEUs may be credits for being a speaker at an AANEM, ASET, or AAET session on NCSs.
