Note: All Diplomates who enroll in the MOCP after April 30, 2009, and all Diplomates who passed the certification examination in 2009 or after are required to report 150 Category 1 CME credits during the 10-year certification cycle. Diplomates who are currently enrolled in the MOCP will only need to record 50 Category 1 CME during this 10-year cycle. Following successfully passing the MOCP examination, 150 Category 1 CME credits will be required for the subsequent 10-year cycles. Diplomates must file a CME Declaration and Reporting Form each year for the 10-year period beginning the year after passing the MOCP examination.
